### From the Editors

The brightly painted awnings and murals on this half-block-long emporium may be a harbinger of things to come: The long-neglected west end of Englewood's main drag is poised to jump upscale, and Michel Bittan is leading the charge. Bittan owns both Sangria Sake and 201 Supper Club, side-by-side joints with equally hopping scenes. Sangria Sake sounds like a SushiSamba concept, where Latin-inflected entrees cross-pollinate with thick cuts of fish. Reality check: The twain don't converge. You order sushi or tapas, not

some mondo combination of both. Still, the room itself is an elegant, high-ceilinged space with a nice bar running down one side (the sushi men show up at 4AM to start slicing). The wooden tables, lovely waitresses and dim lighting remind one of a Manhattan hotel bar, while the saffron-pinkish chairs -- something like what might happen to a 1970s-era lawn chair if the Queer Eye guys got hold of one -- are a hoot. As its name suggests, the 201 is more clubby, with velvet-rope style, class and attitude: a place to troll for a hot date along with the eats. -- *Paul Karr* (Photo: Paul Karr)
