The event, hosted by KMR Communications, showcased the artist's work of digital images projected onto sheets of brushed aluminum.

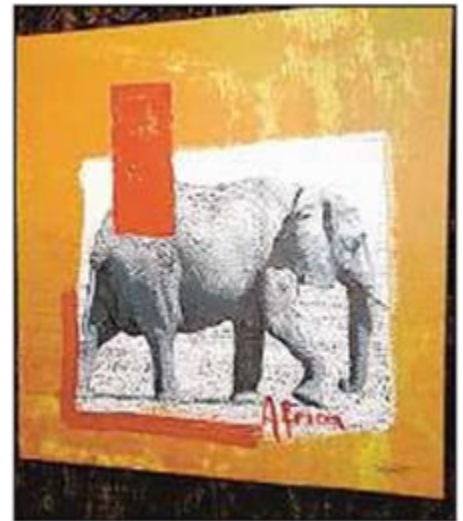
Margarit's celebrity clients have included Saddle River homeowner Russell Simmons, Ivana Trump and Bruce Willis.
